Good morning everyone

At this we would like to remind all of the residents that being a responsible pet owner at the property means the following:

Pets should always be leashed once they hit common area at the property. While it is tempting to just let your pet outside via the slider if you live on the first floor we cannot have this. While you as a pet owner may know your dog would not harm a person or another dog other residents may not feel comfortable passing you if your dog is unleashed. It is a city ordinance and a rule at the property.

If you live on the 2nd or 3rd floor we ask that you not place your pet on the deck unless you are physically there on the deck with them. It is a natural response for dogs to bark when people with or without pets walk by. In order to keep the noise level down it is best for those who live around you to bring your dog in if this happens.

Lastly we ask that you carry a bag or waste removal device whenever you walk your pet.
