Attached is a memo from the Concord Police Department that is open to the public and it's right across the street!

Many residents have brought questions and concerns over the last few years and the police are trying to be pro-active and get information to the residents in Concord.

On another note we have been sending out reminders throughout the summer season with regard to what can and cannot be on the patios and decks as well as what can be stored in the garage areas.

Patios and decks are permitted to have patio furniture and potted plants. Second and Third floor units are permitted to have electric grills only. Those residents that are on the first floor must move their gas grills a minimum of 10 feet from the building when in use. Over the past few months i have noted brooms, shovels, coolers and a number of other items on the decks and patios. Management does not want to be the one to send you a fine therefore we ask that you make sure your patio and deck are compliant with the policies set by the Board of Directors.
