We would like to take this opportunity to thank those of you that moved your vehicles for the snow contractor yesterday.

We would like to remind everyone of the snow removal process. Management will be dropping off the policy at the doors this week. We will also have them posted on the bulletin boards for general reference. You need to move your vehicle off the property by 9:00am so that the contractor can clear the lot.

As you all know the warm weather on Sunday allowed us to clean up the lots. Unfortunately several people did not move leaving the snow contractor unable to perform his job. Today we have several areas that are ice covered. The ice melt does not work in sub zero weather. Clough Landscaping will be sanding some of the troubled areas this afternoon.

The buckets located at every single door are for residents to use. The areas generally melt during the day and freeze at night. If you are out early in the morning please use the ice melt generously.

We have also been receiving complaints from the owners that have parking spaces over by the clubhouse. Please tell your visitors not to park in that area. There are limited spaces for visitors. If there are not visitor spaces they will need to park off site. We cannot continue to have visitors parking in assigned parking spaces.
