Good morning everyone

Those of you that use the building 3 garage have certainly been patient throughout the card reader exchange process. Originally Overhead Door felt that the current wiring was acceptable. It is not. There is a wiring issue. As soon as weather permits they will be feeding new wiring from the reader to the door. This should solve the disconnect in service.

For all residents we ask that should a dumpster be full we ask that you go to another dumpster at the property. There have been instances where the dumpster between 2 and 3 are overflowing with trash on the ground while there was plenty of room in the other two dumpsters. For those of you that have dogs and pick up pet waste we certainly appreciate this however we need you to place the bags into the surround and not throw them over the fence hoping to hit the dumpster.

With spring comes moving. We would like to reinforce the policy of illegal dumping at the dumpsters. The only items we can throw into the dumpster are garbage bags and recycling materials. This means any household items or furniture must be brought to the transfer station. Please note there is a \$250 fine noted on the dumpster surrounds. Please make sure if you have an outside contractor remove furniture or any time of construction material or rugs that they must take them off site to dispose of these items.
