There are people getting into our buildings stating they are from Unitil asking to see your Unitil bills. They have told a number of stories to get you to give them your Unitil or personal information. According to Unitil: THIS IS A SCAM and THEY DO NOT REPRESENT UNITIL!!!!

They will not identify themselves – no business card – no ID. The board treasurer/clerk just had them at her door. They were told to leave the property or the police will be called.

The board has been in contact with Unitil regarding this. Unitil told the board they do not do business this way. They NEVER send people out to solicit business and if we can get the name of this company, they will be more than happy to press charges.

The board cannot stress enough – do NOT buzz people into our buildings unless you confirm who they are. Do not open your door to anyone unless you first know who they are. Please tell your children to not open the building or unit door to strangers.

This is not the first time we have had people solicit from residents here at Oak Bridge. Beware of people requesting or using your personal information without permission and never, ever hand or give any information to people that come a knockin'.
