This email is being sent to all owners and tenants of Oak Bridge.

The board received strong words from the Concord Fire Department on B3 alarm incident today. They requested the board immediately send out this important email to all Oak Bridge owners and tenants.

From the City of Concord Fire Department:

There were numerous tenants in building 3 who did not evacuate the building during today's fire alarm. When a fire alarm sounds, you must **IMMEDIATELY** leave the building until the Fire Department investigates and secures the building; that's how people lose their lives.

If you burn something on your stove which creates smoke, do **NOT** open the unit hallway door where the smoke will fill the hallway, setting off the building's alarm system automatically calling the city Fire Department. Open your slider and all your window to disburse the smoke in your unit.

Please take this life-saving message by the city Fire Department to heart.
