This email is being sent to all owners and residents of building 4.

The City of Concord just notified management they will be here tomorrow – Wednesday Oct. 25 – to remove a dead tree that has fallen across the brook leaning onto Oak Bridge property.

The City is requesting NO VEHICLES PARK in any “P” spot where tree removal work is being done. The spots are all “P” spots that run from the Irvine side of the building to the right (beside Fisherville Road sidewalk). The only last 3 “P” spots at the far right behind the building should be out of the way.

Please make sure you do not park your vehicle in this area tomorrow during work hours. Any vehicle parked there is in jeopardy of being towed by the City at owner cost.

Thank you for your co-operation with this short notice. This tree is a serious safety hazard and we are excited it is being removed at no cost to the Association.
