As a participant in the City of Concord NH's containerized recycling program, you have shown your commitment to the environment. Unfortunately, contamination in the recycling stream has become a significant issue that hinders those efforts and it must be addressed.

Starting March 1, 2020, the City's recycling contractor, Casella Waste is beginning a protocol of material inspections to help address this issue. Casella staff will be inspecting loads of recyclables before the load is collected to identify loads of material which may be contaminated. In the unfortunate event contamination is found, the load of recyclables will be flagged and the load will necessarily be dumped as trash and billed accordingly.

Any containerized recycling dumpster found to have 3 contaminated loads; will be required to lock their containers and purchase special "slotted" recycling lids for the container in order to continue to participate in the program. The City has had success with these slotted lids in various other applications and they have been proven to help prevent contamination.
