The board received a report the fireworks display behind B3 approx. 9PM Saturday night 5/2 were set off by someone in the common area behind the building 3. If you saw someone setting off fireworks behind building 3 or know who they were, please reply to this email.

Fireworks are legal in NH and in the city of Concord, **BUT** you are required to obtain a permit approved by the City of Concord Fire Chief. In addition, please note from the state of NH:

Shall submit the following with this form: Proof of appropriate liability insurance for the display. Site plan – 200 feet from any audience, building, tent/canvas structure. Inventory list of all permissible fireworks utilized during the display. Written permission from the land owner. Attach local permit, if one is required.

If you see anyone setting off fireworks anywhere on property, please **IMMEDIATELY** call the Fire Department (603-225-8517 #6 Manor Station). This is an extremely dangerous activity and is prohibited at Oak Bridge.
