Dear OakB B2 Owners and Tenants,

We noticed there was a glitch in the Eblast system used to send out bulk emails at OakB, which runs sometime after 9PM when needed. This system inadvertently put all building 2 owners' email addresses visible in the To: line. This was a system error.

To address your concerns, neither email addresses nor phone/cell numbers are considered confidential in a court of law. In addition, all property owners are posted publicly on-line in the tax record section of each city/town in the state of NH website where one can look up the name, address and tax information of any property owner in the state. Also, all NH property deeds are posted on-line for anyone to see.

Despite the public access to property owner information posted on-line by the state, we apologize for this glitch as we try extremely hard as a board and management company to not divulge any owner or tenant data, confidential or not. We apologize for this glitch.

If owners/tenants in building 2 abuse this email disclosure glitch, as some have already done, you can block their email address by coding it as junk or spam. Abusing the data disclosed with this error says something about the abuser. We ask you to delete this email message as all eblasts can be found on our website for future reference.

Thank you for your understanding of this software error/glitch. We will be looking into why this happened to prevent this from happening again in the future.
